Philanthropy Committee News:

With a \$35,000 budget for 2014-2015, the Philanthropy Committee is pleased to report the third- \$2,000 payment of our \$10,000 pledge was made in December to Coronado Hospital Foundation. As in the past, this dedicated donation was divided between the Foundation, Coronado Meals on Wheels and Coronado Hospice Care.

Also in December, a \$1,000 donation was made to the San Diego Symphony for tickets to the "Home for the Holidays" concert for military members and their families. Additionally, a \$500 check was sent to Storefront to purchase items on their "Holiday Wish List" and another \$500 was sent to Rachel's Women's Center to pay for shoes and under garments for the women in their care.

At the February luncheon, co-presidents Carrie Downey and Pat Cooley with philanthropy chair Vicki Bernitt made a presentation of \$1,000 to San Diego Youth Services, Storefront for items on the "Living Wish List" of youth needs, shelter needs and ongoing needs.
